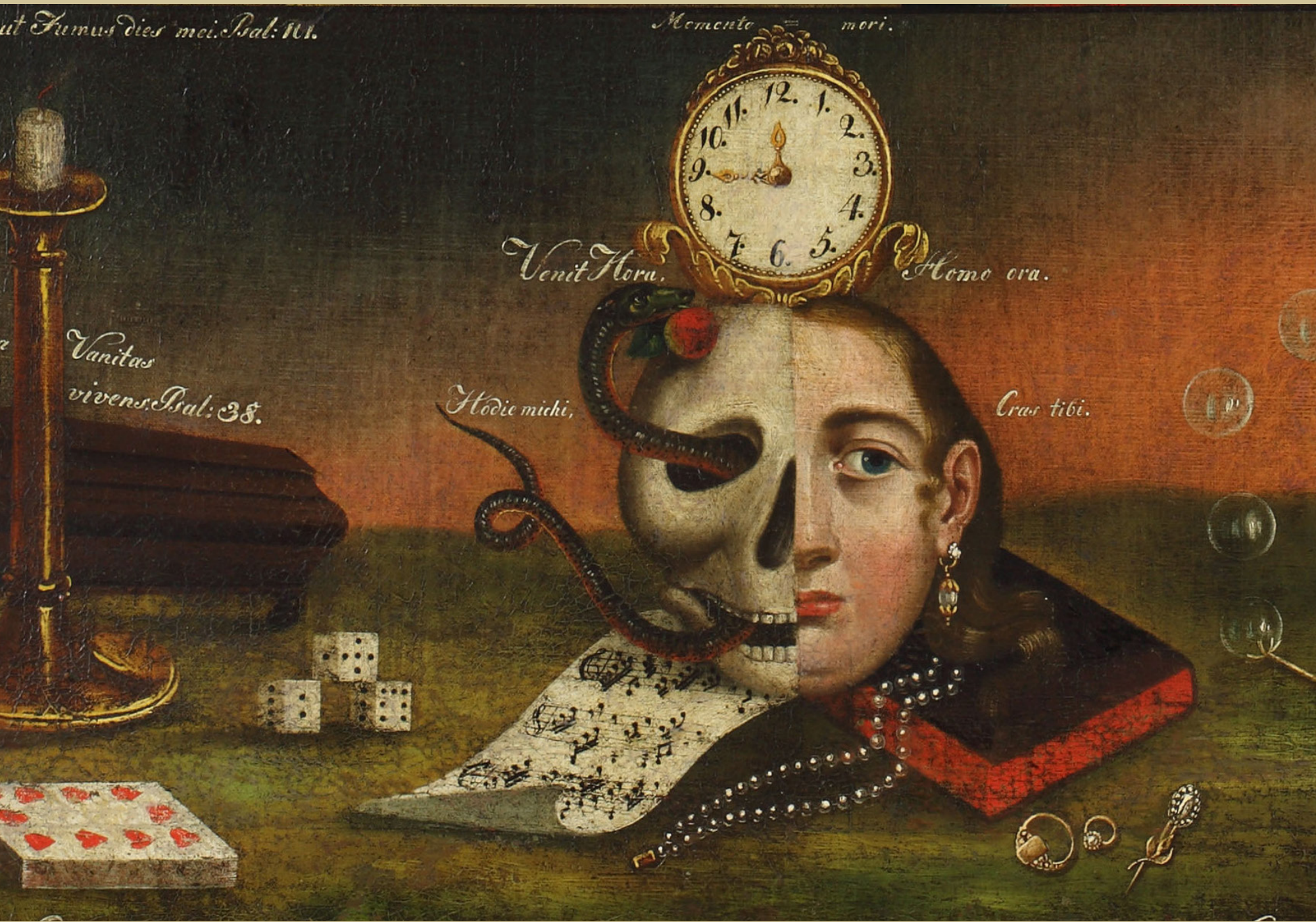


IRW DISTINGUISHED LECTURE SERIES ● 2023-2024
